Levrx is seeking a talented and experienced software/applications developer (SD) to assist in all aspects of product development, deployment, and life cycle management. The SD will coordinate with Levrx leadership, internal and 3rd party development and infrastructure teams, partners, and vendors to build and maintain software applications. In addition, the SD will assist in all aspects of the Software Development Life Cycle (design, development, testing, and deployment), and the creation and enhancement of processes and methodologies used to facilitate the SDLC.

The responsibilities of the SD include but are not limited to:

- 1. Develop desktop and mobile applications based on functional specifications
- 2. Software conceptualization, technical specification, object design
- 3. Design and implement technical architectures and infrastructure for the Levrx product suites
